Through our Fully Inclusive sessions we offer an enhanced experience for your child beyond what the Funding provides which involve charges for meals and snacks, additional hours and activities and the necessary consumables.

Fully Inclusive Funded Session Costs.

Our Fully Inclusive funding can be claimed in 8, 4 or 3 hour blocks each day depending on sessions and availability. Our Sessions are for the set times shown below and are made up of Funded and Unfunded “Private” hours and there are charges for the experiences not included in the Government Funding as follows:

Extra Curricular Activities	Below are examples of the services we provide beyond that provided for by the Government Funding for general play and learning resources, our activities change regularly to ensure maximum stimulation, engagement and participation. Our fees include activities carried out on an increased staff to child ratio so that your child gets the best possible experience, include paying for peripery teachers to deliver the sessions, and any additional resources needed for the sessions: Enhanced External/Garden Activities: Our external areas and gardens are planned and enhanced weekly developing awe and wonder for our children's learning. This develops our children's confidence in what they are engaged in and has a huge impact on their learning and developing. These planned experiences / activities are beyond your everyday continuous provision (general play learning and play) and include a permanent stage area with ever changing (at least weekly) backdrops, props and scenery are used to create imaginative and stimulating experiences. For example: Life size Dinosaur Enhanced Garden Experience (stage activity) - large backdrops (photographer ones), inflatable dinosaurs, materials to make giant sized dinosaurs to sit and ride, tights, real fossils, vines, explorers hats, binoculars, real maps, camouflage nets, real fossils, moulds to create dinosaurs, time machine tent, extensive range, globes, real food, packed lunch boxes, sandwich making, tea, coffee, kettle, cups, sleeping bags, rucksacks, tea, coffee, disposable bbq and the list goes on... Handa's Fruit Kebabs (mud kitchen) - Children are given the opportunity to cut and explore more exotic fruits such as pineapple, guava, mango, pomegranates passion fruit, etc. they use their senses to touch, feel, explore, and taste them. This encourages discussion about healthy eating and provides children with building steps to try something new. Requires specific resources and materials to create a real-life experience. Dinosaurs Love Underpants (outside - Tuff Spot) - activity related to current story children are experiencing. Children are provided with underpants and dyes. The children are given the opportunity to tie dye a pair of pants and use dyes to recreate patterns that the dinosaurs liked in their story. They also experienced the art of tie dying using real material dyes. Beach Enhanced Experience - This gives the children the opportunity to experience going to the beach. It develops children's experiences who had visited the beach as they could make links with past experiences. It developed gross and fine motor skills e.g. using fishing rods to catch fish. It promoted personal, social and emotional development, as the children were able to put on and off costumes and promote narrative in their play. the children had the opportunity to clear up litter so they could have a better understanding of how to look after the environment around them. Developing awe and wonder enhances confidence in what the children are engaged in. This activity involved providing resources including: towels, inflatables, suncream, shaving foam ice cream, scoops, ice cream cones, snorkels, goggles, flippers, swimming costumes, flip flops, sunglasses, hats, pumps to blow up inflatables, beach large backdrops, kayak, litter pickers. External Providers are used to bring specific regular learning opportunities for the little ones using specialist qualified resources, these include: Sessions provided by qualified external Forest School leaders working in our dedicated fully equipped Forest School area developing outdoor confidence, exposure to risk taking and increasing self-esteem. Music, singing, sensory play and dancing opportunities provided by Rockitts Sensory , the highly regarded local specialists in children's play, music and SEND experiences. Evie from Happyface Yoga supports our children's emotional wellbeing through weekly yoga and mindfulness sessions. She teaches simple breathing techniques, movement, and ways to help children self-regulate and feel calm. Evie's sessions are a valued part of our nursery, promoting confidence, balance, and inner calm from an early age. Speech therapist used in specific cases to develop a speech development plan and identify any need for SEND involvement. Enhanced Internal Activities: Cooking: Example: Ramadan Sweet Activity – ingredients purchased for children to make sweets consumed as part of Ramadan celebrations. Children able to enjoy being part of the celebration and take part in distribution to local community Lending Library: we provide resources for a lending library of childrens' books and useful parenting materials and learning packs. Qualified School Teachers - We provide 1:1 learning opportunities with a Qualified Teacher for the children to develop their reading skills and utilise our own externally provided and supported phonics programme to prepare children for school. Our teachers plan and organise our activities and programmes to meet individual needs on a daily/weekly/termly basis to enable our children to have access to a wide range of cultures and new experiences, carried out on an increased staff to child ratio so that your child gets the best possible experience.	£11.98	£5.99	£4.49	£4.49

Tutorials: beyond the minimum requirements of the Government Funding we provide regular videos and other support materials for parents to provide information to help them deal with behavioural and other challenging child development situations they face, examples have included starting school, fussy eating, sleep and toileting. All dietary requirements are catered for in all our meals and we always use top quality ingredients. The cost of the meals includes all food and raw materials and their preparation, cooking, delivery and collection together with the cost of the nursery chefs.

Stretching the Funding.

As Little Pickles is a full daycare nursery which is open for 51 weeks of the year we offer our funded sessions as 'stretched' only. The Government Funding is designed around attendance at nursery for 38 weeks per year. If you are eligible for 15 hours of Funding, over 38 weeks this makes a total of 570 hours per year and if your eligibility is for 30 hours your annual eligibility is 1140 hours. As we are open for 51

weeks we ‘stretch’ the funding over a longer period of 48 weeks. There is a small monthly charge to account for the difference between 48 weeks funding and 51 weeks attendance.

We offer up to 12 hours per week over 48 weeks for parents entitled to 15 hours making a total of 576 hours per year and we offer up to 24 hours per week over 48 weeks for parents entitled to 30 hours making a total of 1152 hours per year. The other 3 weeks we are open are charged at our standard rates.

If the nursery has to close due to any health and safety or illness reasons including bad weather the hours over and above the entitlement are used to cover replacement attendance/sessions up to 6 or 12 hours respectively – there will be no charge if these additional hours are not utilised for replacement attendance.

All Parents must:

- complete a parental declaration using our on-line system – “Funding Loop”.
- provide us with their child’s original birth certificate or passport.
